

### Ageing in Place in Australia: Concepts and Reality

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#### Broadening the meaning of 'Place'

 AIP <u>not</u> necessarily just about 'staying put'

 About enabling people to live in a place that maximises self-fulfilment and preferred lifestyle



#### **Dimensions of 'place' in AIP**

- 1. Houses/Homes
- 2. Locality/Community
- 3. Support/Care



#### Actions, choices and preferences of older West Australians related to 'Ageing in Place'

A Case study



#### **Broad Aim**

To investigate ageing in place intentions in terms of the 3 dimensions of place:

- 1. House and home
- 2. Locality and community
- 3. Support and care



### National Seniors Australia (NSA)

- Largest organisation representing over 50s
- Over 250,000 members nationally
- About 28,000 members in Western Australia
- Represents almost 5% of 50+ population



#### Method

- Random sample of WA members of NSA, stratified by location and socio-economic index
- Mail survey ~ 7,000 (24% of members)
- 3,050 respondents (45% response rate)
- Results weighted to represent WA
  membership
- 39 semi-structured interviews



#### Respondents by age group

| Age group | Number       | %     |
|-----------|--------------|-------|
| Under 55  | 279          | 9.3   |
| 55-64     | 1544         | 51.3  |
| 65-74     | 819          | 27.2  |
| 75+       | 365          | 12.1  |
| Total     | 3007*        | 100.0 |

#### **Respondents – other info**

- 40% left school before year 10; whereas
- 23% had university degree(s)
- 87% owned own house
- 22% living alone
- 49% working full or part-time
- 19% retired on pension
- 57% self-rated health 'excellent/very good'
- 13% they or partner needed some assistance with IADLs or ADLs



#### **Respondents by location**

| Total          | <u>38.4</u> % | 29.6% | 21.4%        | <u>19.9</u> % |



# Distance moved by age group

| Distance     | <55           | 55-64 | 65-74 | 75+           |
|--------------|---------------|-------|-------|---------------|
| < 2km        | <u>11.5</u> % | 15.9% | 14.6% | <u>28.6</u> % |
| 2 - 9km      | 19.7%         | 19.5% | 20.1% | <u>32.5</u> % |
| 10 –<br>49km | <u>26.2</u> % | 17.9% | 16.3% | 22.1%         |
| 50km +       | 42.7%         | 46.7% | 48.9% | <u>16.8</u> % |



#### Why moved by age group

| Where wanted live rest of life          | 20.5        | 29.0        | <u>34.2</u> | <u>36.9</u> |
| Wanted lifestyle change                 | <u>30.8</u> | <u>30.6</u> | 21.5        | 3.4         |
| Employment related                      | <u>27.1</u> | 23.2        | 5.6         | 0.0         |
| To be closer to<br>family/friends       | 5.9         | 17.4        | <u>25.8</u> | 19.6        |
| Retirement                              | 8.4         | 14.8        | <u>29.4</u> | 22.6        |
| Upkeep/ maintenance                     | 8.5         | 14.7        | 21.4        | <u>31.1</u> |



## **'Downsized' from separate house, by age group**

| Residence moved to (%)             | <55        | 55-64 | 65-74 | 75+         |
|------------------------------------|------------|-------|-------|-------------|
| Semi-detached, terrace, town house | 4.7        | 4.8   | 6.0   | 13.5        |
| Flat, unit, apartment              | 2.3        | 8.9   | 17.3  | <u>33.2</u> |
| Total                              | <u>7.0</u> | 13.7  | 23.3  | <u>46.7</u> |



#### Intend to stay as age?

|        | <55         | 55-64 | 65-74 | 75+         |
|--------|-------------|-------|-------|-------------|
| Yes    | <u>37.3</u> | 43.4  | 52.6  | <u>61.9</u> |
| Unsure | 10.8        | 13.1  | 14.9  | 13.8        |
| No     | 51.9        | 43.5  | 32.5  | 24.3        |



#### Why thinking of staying

| Reasons ranked by %<br>'Very Important' | <55         | 55-<br>64   | 65-<br>74 | 75+         |
|---|-------------|-------------|-----------|-------------|
| It is comfortable                       | <u>66.9</u> | 74.9        | 77.2      | 75.6        |
| Financially viable                      | <u>65.8</u> | 74.4        | 74.0      | 71.5        |
| Good location                           | <u>57.3</u> | 70.4        | 67.3      | 69.1        |
| Feel safe and secure                    | <u>53.9</u> | 65.8        | 68.6      | <u>72.6</u> |
| Good location/ access to services       | <u>49.6</u> | 67.3        | 65.9      | 67.8        |
| Like neighbourhood                      | 56.4        | <u>66.9</u> | 61.0      | 58.6        |
| Good neighbours                         | 52.6        | 55.9        | 59.4      | 55.9        |



#### Importance of Home Modifications

- Those who had NOT carried out Mods were 1.38 times more likely to think about moving in the <u>short term</u>
- Those who had NOT carried out Mods were 1.31 times more likely to think about moving in the longer term



# Home Modifications, by age group

#### Some 'conclusions'

- Need to broaden AIP concept
- Each dimension of 'place' influences moving decisions
- Attachment to locality more important with increasing age
- Rural communities increasingly difficult for older people
- Need for more small scale housing
- Modifying home common strategy to enable independence
- As age focus on 'Independence' and place to maximise 'Managing' rather than need for 'Support and
