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What we know

- Vaccination is not part of routine health care
- There are missed opportunities with medical service visits
- Survey results show that people who were not vaccinated during campaigns, visited their doctor during those days

- Vaccination and the impact of infectious diseases are not addressed as an important issue by health teams
- This poor communication between service users and health teams helps myths and fears about vaccination and content is not clarified
- Undervaluing the role of other professionals, besides medical expertise
- Vaccination and multidisciplines
- Poor inter-professional education
- Lack of new vaccines

- Your Doctor may play a role in discouraging vaccination when they are not convinced of the effectiveness and benefits of vaccinations
 - Poor perception of their own risks and their immediate environment
 - Fear of undesired efeects
 - Fear of injections

- Poor skills on the principles of PHC in most specialists: health promotion is alien to everyday practice
- Unawareness of older adults and their environment and needs
- Additional benefits of vaccination
- Unfocused health teams for the population
- The role of Medical Societies and Associations


To take into account from the user...
