The following criteria apply to all individuals who are recommended by a third party or nominate themselves for inclusion.

- A. Internationally recognized expertise in the field of ageing, to be demonstrated by one or more of the following:
 - (i) A record of academic publishing on relevant issues, preferably in peer-reviewed publications
 - (ii) Experience at a high level in global, regional, or national policy development and delivery of programs and services related to ageing
 - (iii) Experience at a high level in the development and management of global, regional, or national initiatives in public health and ageing, or similar functions related to the protection, care, and support of older people
- B. Demonstrated engagement in national and international processes relevant to population ageing
- C. Willingness to participate actively in the IFA Expert Centre by responding to appropriate media inquiries and updating profile information on a quarterly basis
